Community Statement – March 25, 2020

On March 17, 2020, the City provided the following statement on our response to COVID-19:

As of today, the City of Falcon Heights will follow guidance from state and federal health officials. Falcon Heights has closed all facilities to public access from March 18 to March 30 to limit the potential community transmission of COVID-19. City employees will be available by telephone and email during the facility closure. Rest assured that public safety (police and fire) will continue to operate and available.
